SUMMER 2019 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

This summer Cherokee Elementary School will have the Large Group Instructional area lighting added to the emergency lighting system.

The district architect, Wakely Associates, is nearing completion of the design documents for the classroom door lock upgrades and emergency alert system. This project is schedule to go out to bid this summer and work is scheduled to be completed on second shift during the 2019/20 school year.

The design work for the summer 2020 projects has started. This includes playground upgrades, media center upgrades, relocating the Cheyenne Elementary School main office for better security. This 2020 projects also include parking lot work at Huron, Ojibwa, Shawnee, and Sequoyah.

MIDDLE SCHOOLS

At Iroquois Middle School this summer, Esko Roofing will be working on a major section of the roofing and Great Lakes Power & Lighting will be replacing the main electrical service to the building.

At Algonquin Middle School, Great Lakes will be upgrading the choir room lighting

The district architect, Wakely Associates, is nearing completion of the design documents for the classroom door lock upgrades and emergency alert system. This project is schedule to go out to bid this summer and work is scheduled to be completed on second shift during the 2019/20 school year.

The design for the summer 2020 work has started. This includes media center upgrades and renovating the Algonquin Middle School main office for better security.

HIGH SCHOOLS

At Chippewa Valley High School and Dakota High School, the entry vestibule will expanded into the building over the summer to improve visibility and building security.

Dakota High School, Great Lakes Power & Light will be upgrading the Pool lighting.

The tennis courts at both high schools will be upgraded this summer.

At all four high school buildings, BASS will be upgrading the temperature control systems.

The district architect, Wakely Associates, is nearing completion of the design documents for the classroom door lock upgrades and emergency alert system. This project is schedule to go out to bid this summer and work is scheduled to be completed on second shift during the 2019/20 school year.

The design work for the summer 2020 projects is ongoing. This includes parking lot upgrades at Dakota High School Campus, including improvements to Cougar Drive for improve safety and traffic control.

TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

WIRELESS & NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE

Work has begun on upgrading the wireless network district-wide. Site Surveys are being completed for all buildings and cabling has begun at the Middle Schools.

Work will continue through the end of summer in which all buildings are expected to be upgraded to the new wireless network by the start of the 2019-2020 school year.

SECURITY SYSTEM

The new district-wide security system is designed. Equipment has been ordered and when it is received, work in the buildings is expected to begin.

District buildings are currently being prioritized with the high school campuses slated as a priority for completion this summer. The project will continue through the 2019-2020 school year with an expected completion of all district buildings by the end of summer 2020.

STUDENT DEVICES & WIRELESS CARTS

New student devices are being purchased - 40 new student laptop carts [for a total of 1,440 new laptops] for use in Iroquois, Algonquin, Seneca, and Wyandot Middle Schools.
