RECOMMENDED MOTION: “That the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education approve Burke’s Sport Haven for a one-year contract, with an option to renew annually for an additional 5 years, for youth and varsity helmet purchases utilizing unit prices.”

RATIONALE: Aggressive pricing was obtained through the public bidding process RFB 13.2021.

The proposals were reviewed and approved by the Athletic Directors and Purchasing Offices. Funding will come from the General Fund budget for this purchase.

Re: **Recommendation for Award of Bid Package Number 13.2021  
 (Purchase of Youth and Varsity Football Helmets)**

Please review this recommendation for award of Public Bid Package No. 13.2021. The award of this bid will provide unit pricing for the purchase of youth and varsity football helmets needed due to the mandatory ten-year helmet expiration law and/or increased number of players. This contract provides firm, fixed unit pricing for 12 months, with an option to extend pricing on an annual basis for up to five years.

Aggressive bid solicitation included two-week advertisements provided through the State of Michigan's SIGMA website and direct mailing from the Purchasing Department. Public bidding requirements were followed according to applicable State of Michigan laws and Board of Education policies. Four (4) proposals were opened November 24, 2020 and were based upon bidding documents prepared by the Purchasing Department in conjunction with input from both Athletic Directors.

The Athletic Directors and I are recommending award to the low bidder, Burke's Sport Haven, for both types of helmets, shown below in yellow highlight. Burke's offered multiple helmet models for both youth and varsity size helmets. The youth Schutt A-11+ model is being recommended for award since it has the preferred air bladder feature, which is not offered on the Schutt A-11 helmet. The varsity Schutt Vengeance Pro LTD is not being recommended for award since the helmet bladder only inflates on both sides, but not the top. The Vengeance Z10 is not being recommended for award since the face cage is constructed of less durable titanium material. The F7 VTD model is being recommended for award since the bladder can be inflated on the top in addition to the sides of the helmet, the face cage is constructed of more durable carbon steel material with newer technology, thereby making the fit more comfortable and safer, which is reflected in the best Virginia Tech helmet rating and score.
