CLINTON TOWNSHIP — Chippewa Valley High School Choirs is going to host its annual A Cappella for Autism event at 7 p.m. Wednesday, April 19 at the Chippewa Valley HS auditorium.

The concert will feature singers from the high school and groups from Wyandot and Algonquin middle schools.

The event benefits the Macomb/St. Clair affiliate of the Autism Society as well as vocal music programs in Chippewa Valley Schools.
