MOTION #02/06/10 – Moved by Member Bednard and supported by Member Sobah that the Board of Education conducted a hearing on February 08, 2010, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student 02/08/10:CVHS02.

The Student and Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing, and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student 02/08/10:CVHS02 was guilty of *Section IV.9, "Physically assaulting a staff member/student/person associated with the District"* and *IV.39, "Gang Behavior"*.

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 02/08/10:CVHS02 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District. Student 02/08/10:CVHS02 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
