- This is the original Chippewa Valley Schools Basketball League. We have been doing this for 21 years.
- Some people confuse the other league with ours because they get their information out before us. If you have mistakenly registered for the wrong league, please give us a call.
- This is a league that prides itself on providing an athletic experience that is BOTH educational and fun. It is for the kids! Many girls are playing competition basketball for the first time. As parents, coaches, and spectators, we are their biggest role models. Let us make sure we are teaching them good sportsmanship. There will be good calls, bad calls, and some times no calls by the officials. I assure you that we have never had an official make a bad call on purpose. We hope to teach the kids how to win as well as how to lose.
- THIS IS A NO RISK ADVENTURE.** If you are worried about a conflict don't be! Enroll your daughter and if a conflict occurs when practices start, we will work something out. If that is not possible, **YOU WILL RECEIVE A FULL REFUND!!!! (Prior to First Game.)**
- Teams are made up by the grade your daughter is in and by what school she attends. If there are not enough girls in a certain grade or from a certain school, then they may be combined with another grade or school experiencing the same problem.
- The night your daughter practices will be a direct result of when that school allows us to use the gym combined with the night the coach is available. At this time I cannot tell you the exact day and time because the coaches have yet to be determined. Please feel free to volunteer to coach your daughter's team. **COACHES ARE VOLUNTEERS, PLEASE LET US REMEMBER AND APPRECIATE THAT FACT!!!**
- 2nd, 3rd and 4th grade will play on Monday nights (after 6:00pm) 5th and 6th grade will play on Wednesday nights (after 6:00pm)
- Practices will also be after 6:00pm and be held primarily at the school your daughter attends (unless combined with another school, we then go to the coaches school)
- Each player will play at least half the game.
- Request for a particular coach can be made but there is no guarantee that they will be granted. We will try our best. If you are unhappy with the placement of your daughter and it cannot be resolved you will receive a **FULL REFUND. (Prior to First Game.)**
- There is **no food or drink in the gymnasiums.** If you bring treats for after the game, please distribute them in the hallway. **Spectators (siblings) should remain in the gym during games and practices. Do not let them wander around in the halls of the school.**
- Practices should start the last week of September and games should begin the first week of October and run through December 1st.
