- 1. Welcome and Introductions
- Update on New CLP Sex Ed Curriculum Ptak It was stated that the new Special Education curriculum has been very well received. Hope to have data for April meeting. For sure feedback by fall 2024 meeting.
- 3. Update on new pre/post test data collection tools Kherre Kwolek and Walt Demaris have seen growth with each of their class sections in regards to the pre and post test. Kherre stated that she will get the tests to Scott Perryman so that he can begin using them at Mohegan. Kherre will add Scott to the Schoology group. Kherre will send out the most updated information to every teacher responsible for teaching the curriculum. We should be able to see data at the fall meeting for this semester.
- 4. HIV materials found to be in need of updating: Stephanie updated us on the Lansing Health Department report in regards to updated curriculum needed for HIV lessons. Stephanie stated we need to add information to our current materials to be compliant with the law. Stephanie suggested using Pep and Prep sheets from the CDC in order to meet compliance. The goal is to be medically accurate and non stigmatizing of HIV infection. Stephanie showed the suggested Amaze video on Pep/Prep and asked for opinions. The high school students in attendance all said they liked it and approved of it being shown to CV students. Stephanie showed the group a bulletin that explains Pep/Prep from the CDC as an option to use as well. Stephanie discussed with Allison Sadowski about making sure that everyone has the most updated information for the elementary maturation units. Sara Orris will give access to any of the teachers that need the MMH curriculum in digital form (also most up to date). Current MMH HIV videos are available through YouTube and have already been approved by the School Board.
- 5. The new HIV PEP/PREP video and handouts will need to go through the public hearing process. Stephanie asked for Dr. Don Brosky's help to present this at the next board meeting. Needs approval by April 30 at the latest.

6. Allison Sadowski asked if the parents will have access to all the lessons as they have in the past. Stephanie will work with Karen Langlands and Allison Sadowski on this – all will be on Schoology by end of February at latest.
