Instructor's task:

Demonstrate to students' expectations in the classroom. Demonstrate correct way and incorrect way.

What it is	What it is not
Instructors will demonstrate students entering room quietly, sitting in assigned seat, and filling in agenda quietly.	Instructors will demonstrate the incorrect way to enter room and prepare for class
Instructors will demonstrate active listening.	Instructors will demonstrate ineffective listening.
Instructors will demonstrate cleaning up workspace and preparing for dismissal.	Instructors will demonstrate the incorrect way to clean up workspace.
Instructors will demonstrate respectful behavior between peers.	Instructors will demonstrate disrespectful behavior between peers
Instructors will demonstrate respectful behavior to staff and guest teachers.	Instructors will demonstrate disrespectful behavior to staff and guest teachers.

Practice:

Instructor will have students enter in groups of 10 and perform the expectation. Other students will rate the group by giving them a thumb up or a thumb down.

Acknowledge appropriate/expected behavior:

Staff will provide specific verbal praise to students after practice session.
