Behavior Expectation for the Hallways

Location:

Expectations:

- Students will go directly to location
- Have a hall pass
- Stay to the right side of the hall during passing time
- Use appropriate language!
- Help others in need
- Wear clothing that fits.
- Clean up litter-even if it's not yours!
- Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Cell phones and phones should not be used in hallway. Students need them turned off and put away even if allowed use in previous class hour, next class hour or the cafeteria before or after lunch.

Instructor's task:

Demonstrate to students' expectations in the Hallway. Demonstrate correct way and incorrect way.

Instructors will demonstrate students correctly walking in the hallway. Stay to the right.	Instructors will demonstrate the incorrect behavior in the hallways.
Instructors will demonstrate students using appropriate language in the hallway.	Instructors will demonstrate inappropriate language in the hallways.
Instructors will demonstrate students correctly picking up litter or other debris in the hallways	Instructors will demonstrate the incorrect way of not picking up litter in the hallways

Practice:

Instructor will have students enter in groups of 10 and perform the expectation. Other students will rate the group by giving them a thumb up or a thumb down.

Acknowledge appropriate/expected behavior:

Staff will provide specific verbal praise to students after practice session.
