The Student and the Student's parent(s) had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and based on the evidence has reached the following conclusion: Student 10/20/14:DHSS01 was guilty of Section IV.10. "Verbally threatening a staff member/student/person associated with the District" and IV. 39. "Gross Misbehavior".

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 10/20/14:DHSS01 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District. Student 10/20/14:DHSS01 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the district or attending any district function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.

The Student and the Student's parent(s) had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and based on the evidence has reached the following conclusion: Student 10/20/14:SEN01 was guilty of Section IV.1. "Use of Drugs".

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 10/20/14:SEN01 is expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District from October 20, 2014 through the end of the first semester of the school year. Student 10/20/14:SEN is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the district or attending any district during the duration of the expulsion. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
