The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student 01/13/14:ALG01was guilty of *Section IV.1, "Use of Drugs."*

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 01/13/14:ALG01 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District. Student 01/13/14:ALG01 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
