The Board of Education conducted a hearing on April 9, 2018, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student 04/09/18:ALG02.

The Student and the Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing, and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student, 04/09/18:ALG02,

<u>was guilty of:</u> Section IV.10, "Verbally threatening a staff member/student/person associated with the District," Section IV.39, "Gross Misbehavior," and State of Michigan Revised School Code-Section 380.1311a (2).

THEREFORE, it is resolved that Student 04/09/18:ALG02, is suspended from the Chippewa Valley School District, from 04/09/2018, through May 04, 2018. Student, 04/09/18:ALG02, is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function for the duration of the expulsion. **Ayes, all. Motion carried.**
