<u>MOTION #10/22/19</u> – Moved by Member Bednard and supported by Member DeMuynck Zech that the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education held a hearing on October 21, 2019, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student, 10/21/19:MHS01.

The Student and the Student's parent were advised, in writing, of the charges against the Student, the Administration's recommendation of permanent expulsion and all other due process rights required by the law and District policy.

The Board of Education, based on evidence introduced at the hearing, concluded Student 10/21/19:MHS01 violated Sections IV.9 of the Student Code of Conduct entitled, "Physically Assaulting a Staff Member/Student/Personal Associated with the District." The Board of Education also considered the following factors and concluded the Administration had rebutted the presumption against long-term suspension or expulsion: the Student's age; the Student's disciplinary history; whether the Student is disabled; the seriousness of the Student's misconduct; whether the Student's misconduct threatened the safety of any other student or staff member; whether restorative practices will be used to address the Student's misconduct; and, whether a lesser intervention would properly address the Student misconduct.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED: Student 10/21/19:MHS01 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District and is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District-related function

A roll call vote was taken. Member Bednard, yes; Member DeMuynck Zech, yes; Member Aquino, yes; Member Cardamone, yes; Member Patzert, yes; Member Pyden, yes and Member Sobah, yes. **Motion carried.**
