<u>MOTION #11/05/19</u> – Moved by Member Sobah and supported by Member Aquino that the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education held a hearing on November 04, 2019, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student, 11/4/19:MHS03.

The Student and the Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student, 11/4/19:MHS03, was guilty of: Sections IV.10, "Verbally threatening a staff member/student/person associated with the District," Section IV.11, "Non-verbally threatening a staff member/student/person associated with the District," and State of Michigan Revised School Code-Section 380.1311a (2).

THEREFORE, it is resolved that Student 11/4/19:MHS03, be permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District. Student, 11/4/19:MHS03, is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function.

A roll call vote was taken. Member Sobah, yes; Member Aquino, yes; Member Bednard, yes; Member DeMuynck Zech, yes; Member Patzert, yes; Member Pyden, yes and Member Cardamone, yes. **Motion carried.**
