## C.1 Resolution to Consider Designation of Electoral Representative for the June 07, 2021 MISD Biennial Election Mr. Bednard

RECOMMENDED MOTION: "That the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education by resolution indicate that at a special meeting on May 17, 2021 will consider appointment of a designated representative and alternate representative for the electoral body of the MISD biennial election to be held on June 07, 2021 and that the reading of the resolution be waived."

RATIONALE: The Revised School Code provides that board members of MISD be elected biennially on the first Monday in June by an electoral body composed of one person designated by the board of each constituent district. The Revised School Code also provides this Board shall consider the resolution of designating its representative at not less than one public meeting before adopting the designating resolution. With this resolution, May 17, 2021 is being identified as the regular meeting where the districts representative and alternate will be approved. In this resolution the representative and alternate to be designated on May 17, 2021 should be named. On May 17, 2021, in addition to designating a representative and alternate, this Board will need to indicate the name(s) of candidates that the district representative is directed to cast a vote on the first ballot.
