Therefore, it is resolved that Student 06/17/13:MOH04 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District. Student 06/17/13:MOH04 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
