The Student and the Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing, and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board of Education has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student 02/06/12:Iroq01 was guilty of "Section IV.1, "Use of Drugs".

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 02/06/12:Iroq01 is permanently expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District from February 6, 2012 through the conclusion of the 2011/2012 school year. Student 02/06/12:Iroq01 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
