G.1 Resolution for Parenting Awareness Month-March 2012

RECOMMENDED MOTION: "That the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education adopt a resolution proclaiming the month of March 2012 Parenting Awareness Month."

RATIONALE: This proclamation has been announced by Parenting Awareness Michigan (PAM) and celebrates people raising children and promotes year around parenting education and resources.

MEMORANDUM

G.2 Approve New Board Policy #2431.01 – Concussions and Head Injuries: Students and Student Athletes Mr. Roberts

RECOMMENDED MOTION: "That the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education approve new Board Policy #2431.01 — Concussions and head Injuries: Students and Student Athletes and that the reading of the policy be waived."

RATIONALE: Brain injuries as a result of athletic participation are increasing at an alarming rate. Several studies suggest that well above 15 percent of student athletes playing football will suffer a mild traumatic brain injury during the season. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that nearly 2 million brain injuries are suffered by teenage players every year. In 2002, a team of neurologists concluded that athletes who suffered three or more concussions were nearly ten times more likely to experience abnormal responses to head injury and 7.7 times more likely to experience a "major drop in memory performance" and "persistent deficits in processing complex visual stimuli." When compared with similar students without a history of concussions, athletes with two or more brain injuries demonstrate statistically significant lower grade-point averages.

This policy will put in the necessary safeguards to prevent student athletes from returning to participation too soon following a concussion, while providing the necessary steps for identification and recovery.
