

2024 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS BP4C

Flooring Replacement

Cheyenne Elementary

- Approx. 70,000 sq.ft. of carpet & vinyl tile

- Originally installed in 1999 (25 years old)

Ojibwa Elementary

- Approx. 80,000 sq.ft. of carpet & vinyl tile
- Installed in 2000/2001

Note: Original Bond project planned for 2022 (previously put on hold due to COVID cost escalation concerns)




2024 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS BP5D

Chippewa Valley High School

Install Synthetic Turf in South D-zone

- Currently asphalt (Approx 8,000 sq.ft.)
- Same vendor that originally replaced main field turf in 2000
- Allows for more practice space now that scoreboard &
- flagpole have been relocated (matches Dakota stadium)
- Scheduled to start at Spring Break and complete in 2-3 weeks (weather permitting)



\$270k Total Budget

2024 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS BP5E

Emergency Generator

Central Office Complex

- Replace existing generator (400kw/500kva), originally installed in 2001 with technology center addition, currently on temporary generator

- Add 2nd generator for Central Kitchen (350kw/438kva)

- converting from diesel to natural gas
- capacity: approx. 1,000 gallons (runs 36 hours)





\$1M Total Budget (partially funded by Food Service Department)

Elementary School Highlights

Clinton Valley - replace classroom mechanical units, - replace corridor & cafeteria vinyl flooring Fox - replace carpet & vinyl flooring Mohawk - replace gym flooring Ottawa – replace media center & music room flooring

Middle School Highlights

Algonquin – replace 2 rooftop gym mechanical units Wyandot - replace south parking lot

High School Highlights

CVHS 9th Grade – replace select roofing & boilers CVHS - upgrade elevator, replace select mechanical equip, - replace toilet room underground plumbing Dakota High - replace indoor running track surface & replace auditorium seating Mohegan – replace select mechanical equipment

Administration Building - Replace select mechanical equipment

Secure Entry Upgrades


Sequoyah & Shawnee Elementary
