

Cell Phones / Electronic Equipment

Unless otherwise stated, cell phones and all other electronic devices must be placed out of sight, and the sound should be turned off while in class, restrooms, or locker rooms. Any student found to be in violation of this expectation will have his or her phone/device confiscated with the appropriate consequence as follows:

- First Offense – The student will receive a warning and will retrieve the device at the end of the day from the main office. A parent will be contacted.
- Second Offense – A detention is assigned, a parent will be called, and the student will retrieve the device at the end of the day from the main office.
- Third Offense - An after-school detention is assigned, and the parent will be required to pick up the device.
- Fourth Offense - The student will receive a one-day suspension, and the parent will be required to pick up the device.
- Fifth Offense – The student will receive a two-day suspension, and the parent will be required to pick up the device.

Smoking/Vaping/E-Cigarettes

- The possession or use of tobacco, JUUL or e-cigarettes, or the act of smoking or vaping is not permitted in the buildings, on school grounds, at bus stops, or at any school-related activity (on or off the campus).
- The Clinton Township Police Department will issue a ticket for any student found to be in possession of tobacco/nicotine at school. In addition to this fine, students will be subject to the following progressive disciplinary action:
 - First offense – 3-day out-of-school suspension, complete online course with the SA.
 - Second offense – 5-day out-of-school suspension, complete online course with the SA
 - Third offense – 7-day out-of-school suspension
 - Possession of THC – automatic 10-day out-of-school suspension
