Meal Changes for the 22/23 School Year

The federal USDA waivers that allowed school districts to provide breakfast and lunch at no cost to students expired on June 30, 2022. For the 2022/2023 school year, families who do not qualify for free or reduced meals will resume paying full prices for school meals.

If your student qualifies for free or reduced meals, **you must complete the 2022-2023 online application at [Chippewavalley.familyportal.cloud](https://chippewavalley.familyportal.cloud)** to receive this benefit. Even if you completed the 2021-2022 application, you still need to complete the 2022-2023 application as well. Completing an application is the **only way** to be considered for free or reduced meals next school year.

In addition, Chippewa Valley Schools has made the decision to cover the cost of students that qualify for reduced price meals for the 22/23 school year. This means there will be no charge for breakfast or lunch for all students that qualify for free or reduced meals.

If you do not qualify for free or reduced meals, you may begin depositing money into student accounts at any time to prepare for the cost of school meals next year. Meal prices for the 2022-2023 school year will be \$2.75 for elementary lunch, \$3.00 for middle/high lunch and \$1.55 for breakfast at all grade levels. We have been fortunate to have not changed the prices for the last 9 years.
