

## PAINTED PARKING PERMIT

For \$20, <u>any senior</u> may purchase a permit to paint a parking spot. This will then be their reserved spot for the year. To participate parents must go to payschoolsevents.com to purchase both a parking pass and a painted parking permit. By making that purchase, parents and students agree to all of the following:

- Do not paint on the yellow lines. All painting should be inside of the yellow lines in a single parking space.
- Painting must be school appropriate and meet the following standards:
  - Painting may not depict, imply, advertise, or advocate illegal, violent, or lewd conduct, weapons, or the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana or other controlled substances.
  - Painting may not depict or imply pornography, nudity, or sexual acts.
  - Painting may not display or imply vulgar, discriminatory, or obscene language or images.
  - Painting may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
- Anything deemed inappropriate will be painted over.


Other students will be expected to not park in these reserved spaces. If someone does park in a reserved space, the owner of the space should report the license plate number of the violating car to our main office. No other action should be taken.

Students are responsible for purchasing their own primer, paint, and painting materials. Keep in mind that this could be an expensive activity.

Parking spots may be claimed on a first come basis beginning on August 15 at 7:00 AM. Spots may be painted from August 15 – September 3.

You will be painting over spots painted by last year's seniors. (There are some spaces in the designated rows that were not painted last year). Make sure that you clearly paint 2023 somewhere in the spot to indicate that it has been claimed for this school year. Do not paint a spot that has 2023 painted in it.

Only spaces in the highlighted rows below are available for painting (the red row was recently added):



Failure to meet the above expectations or painting a spot without purchasing a permit could result in loss of painted parking privileges or all parking privileges.
