



PAINTED PARKING PERMIT

Parking passes are \$50. For an additional \$25, **any senior** may purchase a permit to paint a parking spot. This will then be their reserved spot for the year. To participate parents must go to PaySchools Events to purchase a parking pass combined with a painted parking permit.

If making a painted parking spot purchase, parents and students agree to all of the following:

- Do not paint on the yellow lines. All painting should be inside of the yellow lines in a single parking space.
- Painting must be school appropriate. It may not depict, display, state, imply, advertise, or advocate any of the following:
 - illegal, violent, or lewd conduct, or weapons.
 - the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, or other controlled substances.
 - pornography, nudity, or sexual acts.
 - vulgar, discriminatory, or obscene language or images.
 - hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
- Anything deemed inappropriate will be painted over.

Other students will be expected to not park in these reserved spaces. If someone does park in a reserved space, the owner of the space should report the license plate number of the violating car to our main office. No other action should be taken.

Students are responsible for purchasing their own primer, paint, and painting materials. Keep in mind that this could be an expensive activity.

At the time of purchase, you will be indicating your chosen parking space by number. Spaces 47 – 118 and 328 – 423 are available on a first come, first served basis. Spaces 119-144 are numbered, but not available for purchase at this time. You will be painting over spots painted by last year's seniors. (Please note that a small number of these spaces were not painted last year).

Parking spots may be painted beginning on August 14 at 7:00 AM. All painting must be completed by September 2.

Failure to meet the above expectations or painting a spot without purchasing a permit could result in loss of painted parking privileges or all parking privileges.
