Remote Learning or CVVA Learning

	District-Wide Remote Learning	Chippewa Valley Virtual Academy (Family Choice)
Duration	Remote start may transition to hybrid learning or traditional face-to-face learning during the school year	<p>Up to a full academic year with considerations at trimester/semester</p> <p>A student/family can petition to return to district-wide learning scenario at the trimester/semester mark. Requests will be approved based on spaces available.</p> <p>In 2021-2022, students will return to the school they were scheduled to attend during the 2020-2021 school year.</p>



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Remote Learning or CVVA Learning

	District-Wide Remote Learning	Chippewa Valley Virtual Academy (Family Choice)
Instructional Model	Learning format may change based on the latest public health data and state directives	A consistent learning format
Registration	Students currently registered in the district are not required to complete additional registration forms. Students are automatically enrolled.	Students currently registered in CVS may elect to <u>enroll</u> in CVVA by August 13, 2020 Students currently enrolled in CVVA may <u>opt-out</u> by August 13, 2020



Factors to Consider When Making a Family Decision

- Your child's ability to be self-paced
- If your child has a 504 or IEP, and if a virtual approach is best for them
- Your family needs
