ADMISSION STEPS

Since the College has moved to remove services, we have adjusted our admission steps accordingly. Please note the following steps that will be provided to students in their Admission Account once their applications have been processed. Note that Course Planning is not required for dual enrolled students – but IS required for students applying and planning to attend Macomb after graduating from High School.

Placement testing

For many students, placement testing will be "completed" during the SAM session when an academic advisor will review the student's self-reported HS GPA and/or self-reported SAT/ACT score. Students do NOT need to provide a copy of SAT/ACT scores or a HS transcript for this process. When possible, placement testing will be waived with this information. If testing is unable to be waived, students will be walked through the process of remote placement testing, which will be done on a very limited basis only when needed.

1. New Student Orientation

New Student Orientation is required. Visit the <u>log in page</u> to complete orientation. You need your User ID to log in. Select the (New Student/Transfer/Guest/Starting College While in High School) Path. Your User ID is: **1234567**

2. Starting at Macomb (SAM) Session

Macomb Community College campuses are closed to the public and admission steps are now completed virtually. To request a SAM session, please submit the Starting at Macomb (SAM) Meeting form and an academic advisor will contact you to complete this step.

3. Placement Testing

Macomb Community College campuses are closed to the public and admission steps are now completed virtually. Once your Starting at Macomb (SAM) session is complete, we will work with you to determine whether placement testing will be required. We may review your self-reported high school GPA and/or self-reported SAT/ACT scores to make this decision. If testing is required, you can prepare for the placement test by using these <u>practice materials</u>.

4. Course Planning Session

Macomb Community College campuses are closed to the public and admission steps are now completed virtually. If this is your first time in college and you have already completed your Starting at Macomb (SAM) session and the Placement Test (if needed), please email askanadvisor@macomb.edu. We will respond as soon as possible to discuss email or phone options for completing your Course Planning session.
