- Find a quiet, distraction free work area. (Out of sight = out of mind)
- Keep those "little" distractions out of sight. LITERALLY, KEEP THEM WHERE YOU CAN'T SEE THEM. (Things like; cell phone, iPad, video games, TV, NOVELS, music, toys, etc.)



- Arriving 5 MINUTES EARLY = ON TIME
- Arriving as CLASS IS STARTING = LATE



Your Camera must be turned on so your teacher can see you & your "Live video shot" must be of your face. Putting up other images or words is not allowed.



Students using inappropriate language will be muted by the teacher and are expected to continue with the lesson. When appropriate, teacher will privately address any issues with student/parent and forward any discipline issues to administration.



Students are expected to stay "Muted" until called upon or their raised hand symbol is recognized by the teacher. All students are encouraged and expected to participate in classroom discussions and dialogue, but we need to follow the teacher's virtual classroom expectations/norms to ensure all voices are heard.



We understand and appreciate the age of our students and their need to move. Teachers will schedule brain and movement breaks throughout the day as they work with you. when the teacher is presenting the lesson for the day, we ask that students remain seated, quiet and facing their camera.
