CVVA Overview

The Chippewa Valley Virtual Academy is only available to students who are enrolled as a Chippewa Valley student. Our district staff, including administration and teachers who are providing the virtual/remote support and instruction, are committed to the rigor and expectations that students would expect in any public-school environment. The same curriculum will be followed in the traditional and virtual classroom setting, with instruction adjusted to maximize student learning. Students and families must be aware that we may not be able to provide all courses and experiences that may be available in our physical schools. We are proud that CVVA courses will be taught by certified Chippewa Valley Schools teachers. The focus of the CVVA is to provide students with essential knowledge and skills necessary for future learning and graduation. Placement into the CVVA is a yearlong commitment. Movement in and out of the virtual academy during the school year cannot be accommodated. This will allow for the most cohesive learning experience for our children. After one school year in the CVVA, students will be automatically returned to their home schools. Chippewa Valley Schools remains committed to the philosophy that there is no replacement for in-person instruction. We also recognize that every child has different needs and circumstances, which is why we established the CVVA.

CVVA Expectations*

I, as a parent/guardian, agree to the following requirements:

- Lessons will be delivered using the Schoology platform.
- Grading and assessment will be part of the CVVA experience and will require that students are engaged, turning in their homework, and preparing for assessments.
- Prior to enrolling in CVVA, parents of students with IEPs or 504 Plans must contact their case managers, social workers, or counselors to discuss whether FAPE can be provided through the CVVA.
- Students must have computer cameras on when requested by the teacher.
- It may be necessary for students to be physically present in our school buildings for certain assessments in which students will be required to participate. Students who are entering our buildings will be expected to follow all health and safety guidelines as outlined by the district.
- Students must come to school for state assessments.
- On occasion, students will be required to pick up materials from school.
- Certain CTE courses will require parent permission and supervision to participate in some activities. Example - Culinary Arts students will be learning proper cutting and chopping skills.
- Certain CTE certification exams require students to be physically present in school.

Courses and Grading*

I, as a parent/guardian, agree to the following requirements:

- Students in elementary and middle school enrolling in the CVVA will have schedules created for them, which will reflect the experience our children in our traditional brick and mortar schools would experience.
- High School students enrolling in the CVVA will have schedules created using the course request forms we have on file. In cases where specific courses are not available,

our school counselors will replace courses with suitable substitutes that will provide similar experiences and meet Chippewa Valley Schools graduation requirements. This follows the same process as traditional scheduling.

- We cannot currently name all courses that will be offered online as it depends on our enrollment and course request numbers. Some special programs and CTE programs may not be offered, as it will be based on enrollment and course request numbers. If we have the necessary enrollment and interest, some CTE and AP courses will be offered with our Chippewa Valley instructors.

Home Learning Environment*

I, as a parent/guardian, agree to the following requirements:

- Students who have success with virtual instruction need to be organized and develop a daily routine.
- Students enrolling in the CVVA must be willing to work independently at times.
- Students will need to be able to analyze, critically think, and reflect on their performance so that they can seek additional support as needed.
- Our teachers will be available throughout the school day, but will have full time responsibilities with a full caseload of students, whether fully virtual or as part of the traditional schooling approach.
- While the virtual academy does provide some flexibility for students, those committing to this instructional model must understand that teachers will have set hours of availability.
- Students will need an adult educational coach and/or support system at home to be successful with this approach.

Technology Needs*

I, as the parent/guardian, agree to the following requirements:

- CVVA students will be provided with a district laptop for use, which will be checked out from their home building. District laptops are Windows 10 and will be filtered by the district internet policies. Any programs needed for educational use will be provided by the district.
- Students using a district device will be responsible for following the district Acceptable Use Policy and the procedures outlined in the 1:1 Handbook. This includes being responsible for any damage to the laptop while checked out to you.
- If you choose to use a personal computer, the district cannot provide technical support outside of logins for district programs.
- If you are signing up for the CVVA, the district expectation is that you have access to a reliable Wi-Fi connection.

I, as the parent/guardian have read, understand and agree to this information as related to enrolling in the CVVA.*

- I understand that I am expected to follow a traditional schedule as best I can, even though I will be educated in a virtual environment.
- I understand that our district's research and documentation about students experiencing their education virtually show that successful students are motivated, organized, and stick to a daily schedule, five days a week.
- I understand that my student will be expected to have their camera on when expected to by the teacher.

- I understand that I may need to enter a physical building for specific state assessments or unit assessments. Accommodations for these situations will be made whenever possible.
- I understand that I will be expected to take part in live virtual instruction, discussion boards, or other specific time responsibilities while part of the CVVA.
- I understand that I will be asked to take traditional assessments, complete daily work, and be engaged with my teacher throughout the virtual experience provided through the CVVA.
- I understand that I am responsible to submit assignments and be in attendance regularly if I want to continue to be part of the CVVA.
- I understand that my virtual instructor may be unable to be "virtually present" on given days, and that it will be my responsibility to engage with resources provided by the teacher, virtually, and complete work provided through Schoology that day.
- I understand that if I do not follow the expectations and requirements of the CVVA, I may be told that I am not eligible to continue as a virtual student in the CVVA.
