Hero in the Hallway

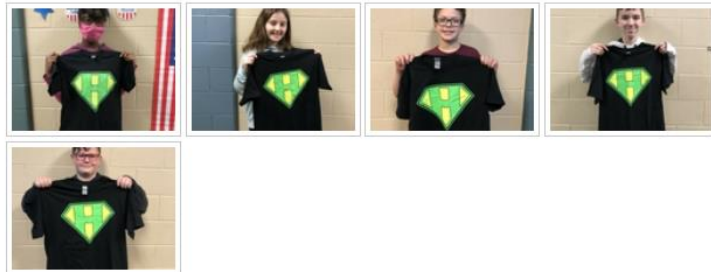


- Anti-bullying program

Daily Schedule

- 7:15 school opens - enter door #7
- 7:30 students may enter through main office or pod doors
(Report to cafeteria)
- 7:51 students allowed in locker areas
- 7:58 first hour begins
- 2:42 end of day

Daily Schedule

- Six class periods per day
 - 6th grade core classes in the same area (6th grade pod)
 - 6th grade lockers located in 6th grade pod.
- 5 minute passing time
- Daily lunch approx. 30 min.
