TECH TURN-IN

All laptops and hot spots should have been returned to school buildings. If you were not able to turn in district technology, building staff will be available until June 23rd, please contact the building for hours. After the 23rd, technology can be dropped off at the Administration Building (19120 Cass Ave.) M-Th from 8-4:30.

*If the current technology (laptop or hotspot) is not returned by June 25th, a fine in the amount of the cost of the device will be assessed in PaySchools. Your student will not be able to check out a device next school year until the device is returned or the fee is paid.

*If you are attending an official district summer school program you will receive information about checking out a device for that program. You cannot keep the current checkout as they need to be prepped for 1:1 next fall.

BACKGROUND ON 1:1

What is 1:1? One-to-one refers to one computer for every student.

The Board of Education voted in October to move to 1:1. Over the course of this school year an additional 12,000 computers were delivered to enable us to provide one for every student.

1:1 IN CVS

Starting this fall, all CVS students will have a computer assigned to them. As you can see, our rollout is going to be Rock and Roll themed! Students will have set lists, rock tours, and a backstage pass to learn all about caring for their device and using it effectively. There will also be learning opportunities and training available for parents.

K-5 computers will not come home every night. They will be stored in carts and can be sent home for projects or assignments at the teacher's discretion. In the event of a shut down students will be able to bring their computers home. Students in grades 6-12 will take their computers home every night. They will be expected to bring it to school charged every day.

As the school year approaches, we will be sharing more information on what students and parents can expect.
